

The Repair For Our Benito Juarez Statue

The National Park Service (NPS) has selected two of the top conservation contractors—Worcester Eisenbrandt, Inc. and Kreilick Conservation, LLC—to begin work on the Benito Juarez Statue. In early December, the contractors plan to begin removing the facing stones of the pedestal to make repairs and they will send more information regarding the specific dates. Work will continue on-site (weather permitting) until early January.

There will then be the seasonal winter shutdown, with a return by the NPS in early spring to finish the landscape work. This project will repair the statue pedestal, restore the bronze statue, restore the plaza

pavers, repair the night lighting of the statue and improve the landscape beds. Many thanks to Jennifer Talken Spaulding, NPS Acting Chief of Resource Management, for her enthusiasm and support for our community and Juarez Circle.
